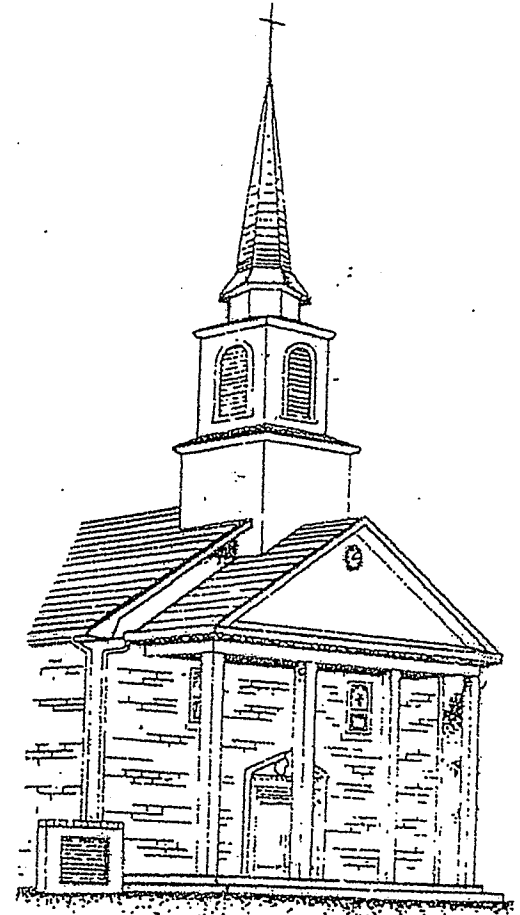

There will be a special called Business Meeting next Sunday following the morning worship service. Below is the recommendation from the Building & Grounds Committee and the Finance Committee. This will be voted on next Sunday.

Recommendation: The ice machine in the Fellowship Hall is out of order. The compressor is out and will cost \$1,072.68 to repair. The price of a new ice machine will be \$2,153.08 plus tax. Our machine was purchased in 2004 and has required several service calls in the past few years. Since the repair is almost half the cost of a new one, and because of the age of our old machine, the committees recommend that we replace the ice machine instead of repairing it.
