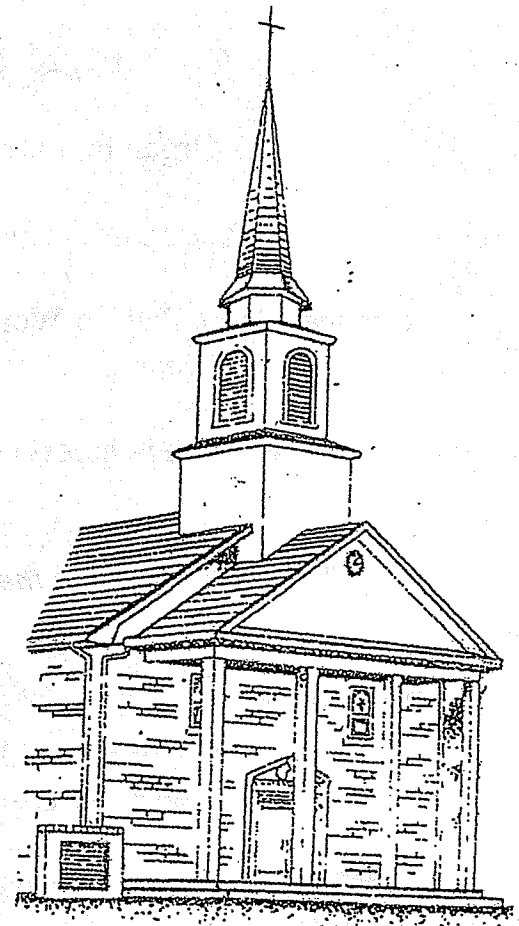

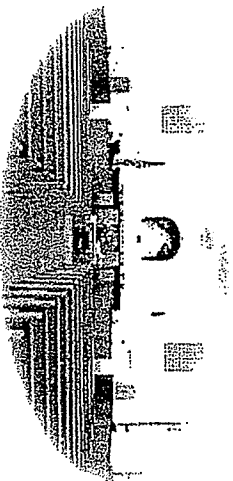


Minutes from business meeting
