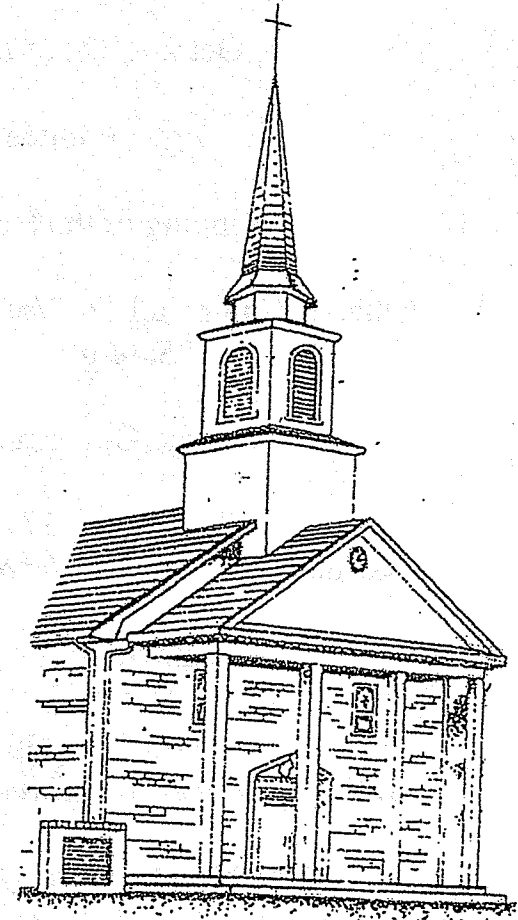


Minutes from business meeting
