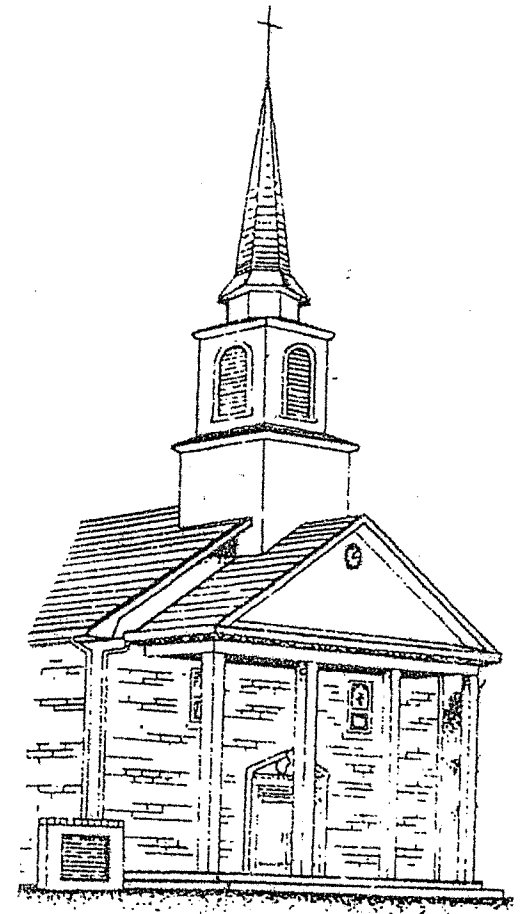

Distributed 1492 pounds of clothing

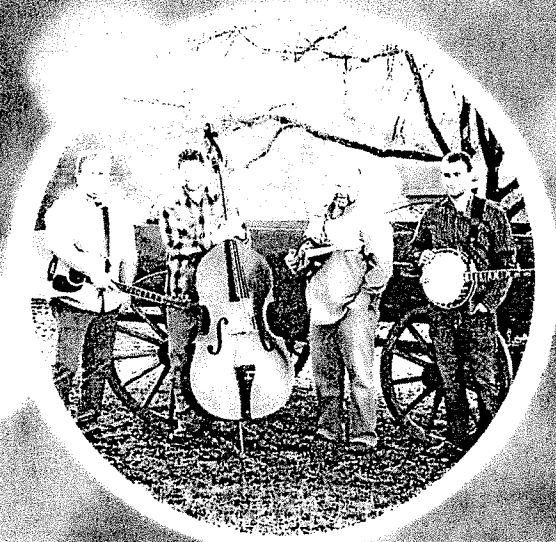

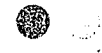
