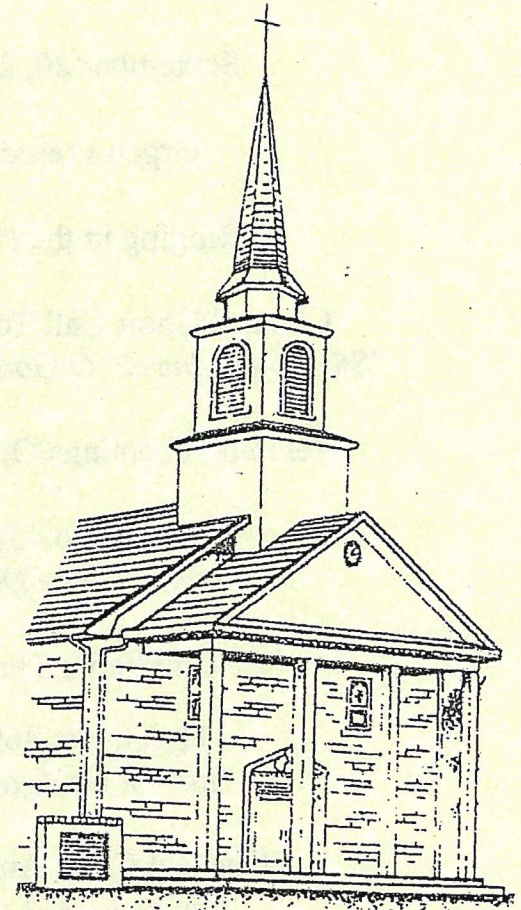

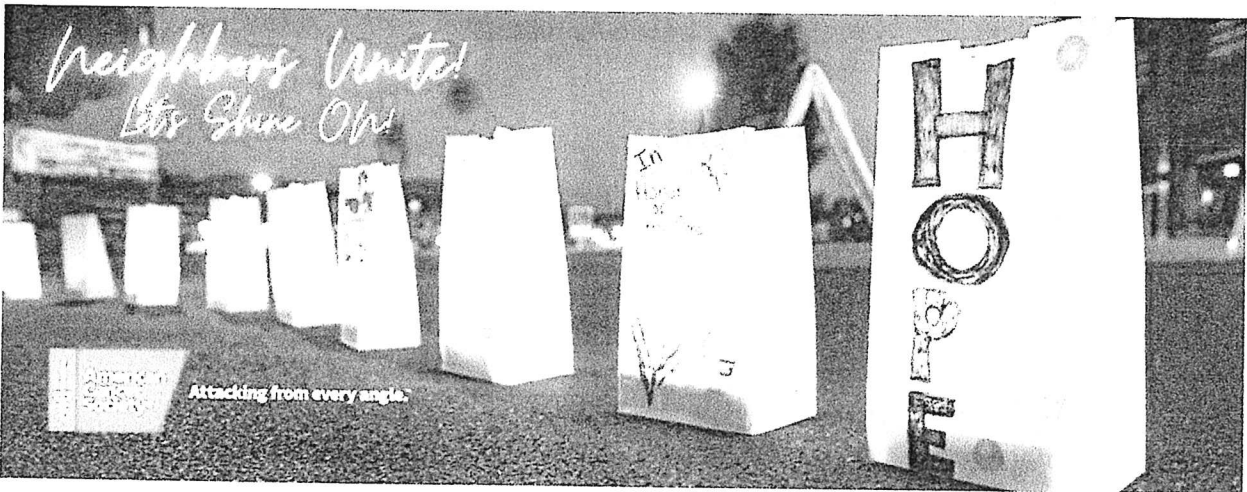
**CBC Opportunities/Announcements**
