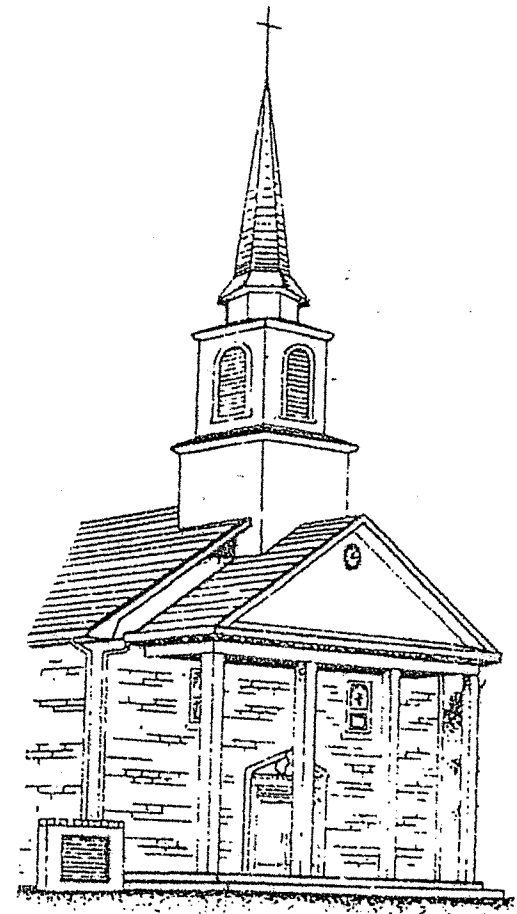

## **CBC Mission Report 2020**

The Covid 19 Pandemic continues to impact our community, but it didn't stop the compassion we've shown others. Through your generous gifts, you embody the love of Jesus to people that have a variety of needs.

### **How Hungry Is America?**

25% of residents in our area indicate that they do not have sufficient funds to purchase food. NC ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the nation for the most children and seniors that are food insecure. Stop and think, 1 out of every 5 children and seniors don't know where their next meal will come from and often go to bed hungry.

They look to Food Pantry's and free meals at schools to bridge the gap. 60% of students qualify for free breakfast and lunch, 900,000 in NC alone. More than 1 in 10 seniors are living in poverty, 49,000 seniors fall at, or below poverty level. A large percentage are due to seniors raising 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> generations (grandchildren and great grandchildren) on a fixed income, that is in part due to the opioid epidemic. There are no programs to help grandparents raising children in their golden years.
