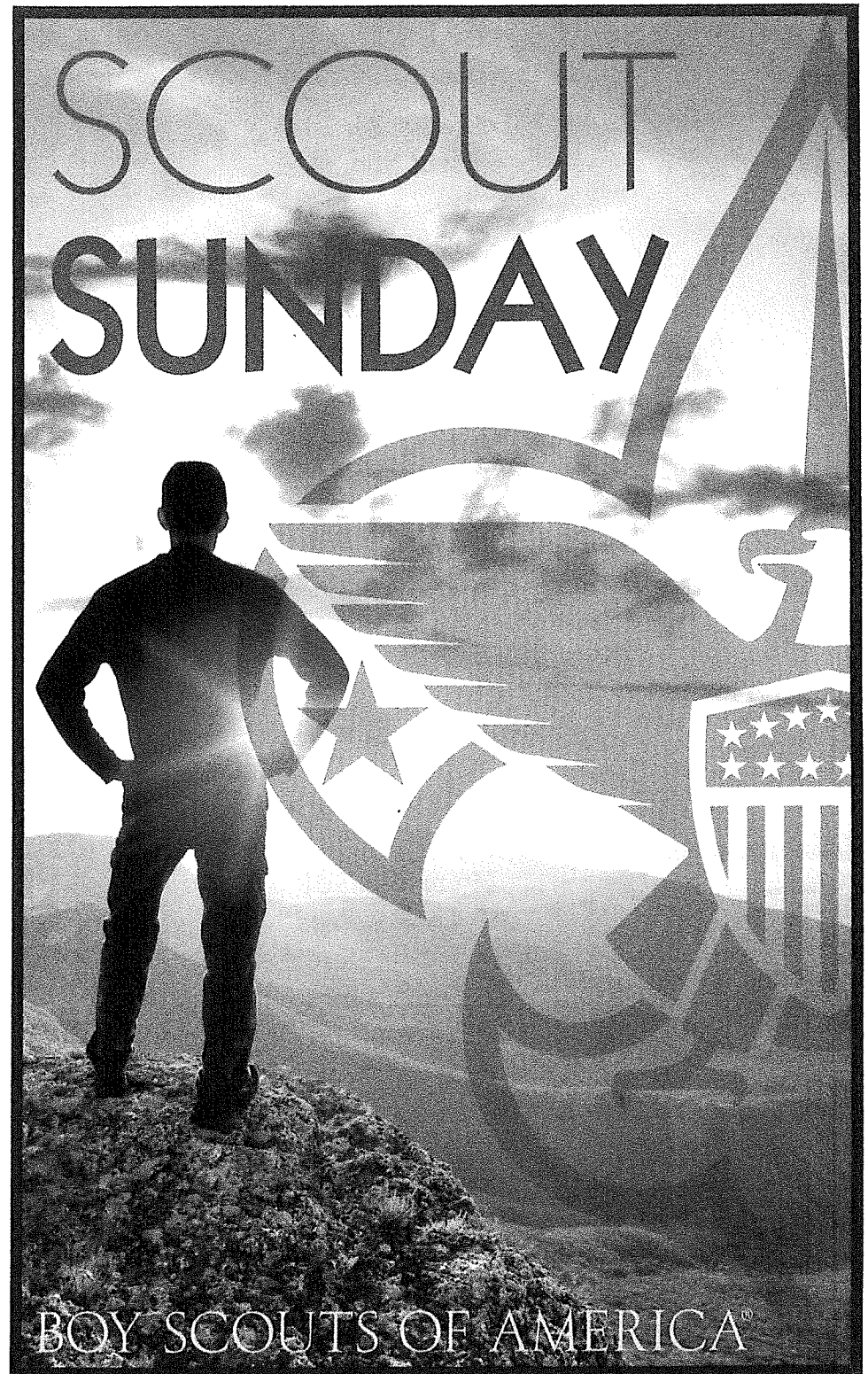


A Scout Is Reverent
