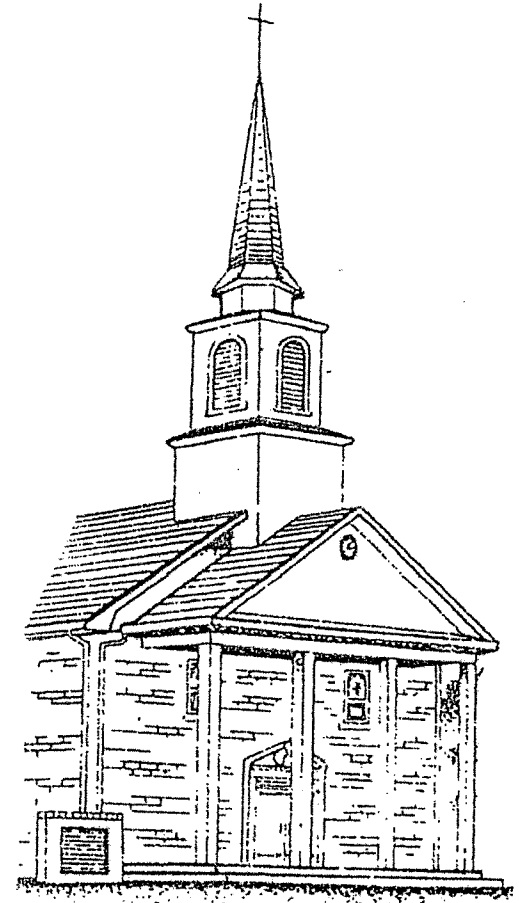

## **CBC Mission Report 2021**

The Covid Pandemic continues to impact our community, but it doesn't stop the compassion we've shown others. Through your generous gifts, you embody the love of Jesus to people that have a variety of needs. Our church is always at its best when we are working together serving others.

### **Mission Focus KIDS CLUB - What is The Kids Club?**

**Kids Club Mission:** To love God by meeting them where they are and encouraging them toward a lifelong relationship with Christ. A Christian environment is created by volunteers. where children come, feel safe, loved, and have fun while being led to hear the voice of God. Our Youth volunteers are an important part of this project because they interact with the younger children.

Revisit your childhood. Remember... What Vacation Bible School was like! Was it fun? Did VBS have an impact on you? Your children? Neighborhood kids? Did you have a snack? Did you look forward to one week each summer? Most of us would say yes!!!

That's what Kids Club is a Bible School, but once a week children interact with others from 5:00 – 7:00 on Saturday evening. While this gives parents a 2 hour break weekly, children are praising God through music, a relatable children's message prayers, Bible drills, sharing a meal (usually pizza), outdoor games and activities. The average attendance ranges from 15 to 50 kids.

Jesus Bucks are rewards for attendance, inviting a friend, participation, good behavior, kindness and helping others. There's a prize room with toys, games and gifts that are purchased and also donated. Jesus Bucks are used to purchase items from prize room, its rewarding to see them purchase items for others, their parents during Christmas as well as themselves.

### **CBC Missions Doing our Part**

**West Davidson Food Pantry** Through your donations cans of soup and garden peas were purchased to replenish our supply at WDFP. Snacks and canned pasta were purchased for weekend backpack programs. Each dollar donated went to a very worthy cause and helped WDFP through hard times to feed others. Our biggest challenge is funding for Weekend Backpack Feed Program. Due to Covid we weren't able to hold fundraiser to raise money for this program.

**The Brotherhood** worked together and shared God's love by helping to repair a ramp and build a new ramp for handicap access. Lawns were mowed, trees trimmed, and wood was cut and delivered. Needs were fulfilled and an impact was made on our community. Smiles and joy were all the rewards needed. The Brotherhood meets on the last Tuesday night each month at 6:00. Come and join us to find about community mission projects.

**The BYW** provided shoe boxes filled with toiletries and treats to local homeless shelter as a monthly Mission Project, also blankets were purchased and provided. Donations were collected and made to the Dragonfly House and to the CBC Afterschool and Preschool to purchase needed supplies. Canned foods

were collected for our Relay for Life Team to fill luminaries. Often we don't know how lives are touched by our projects, but are greatly appreciated. BYW meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday night each month at 7:00 and we would love you to join our Baptist women.

Through **Local Missions** Funds we able to help with a donation to a family that lost belongings to a home fire. Also, were able to provide money for a ramp. We saw many tears, smiles, and grateful hearts. Often we don't realize the outreach our church has on others in our very own back yard.

**Hope in Motion** is our church's Relay for Life team. We feel it is our mission to bring awareness to cancer and raise money to fight cancer. We also strive to remember and honor those who have fought the fight and are still fighting.

We will not have a Davidson County specific Relay for Life event this year due to Covid. The event will be later this year. It will be July 3, 2021 starting at 6:00 pm to midnight at Western Guilford High School.

We will still sell luminaries for this year's event. People can go online to our Hope in Motion Relay page or buy them from any Hope in Motion team member.

CBC plays a significant role with Community involvement as seen with charter and support of our **Boy Scout, Cub Scout and Girl Scout Troops**. They take on many community projects and appreciate the support our church provides.

Our church is so grateful to our **Youth**, thank you for preparing breakfast after Sunrise service. At Thanksgiving food was provided for meals and Christmas gifts were provided for 6 children and teens. Thank you Youth for your serving hearts.

The mission of **Change for Change** is to teach our young children how to show the love of God and serve others in our community. The kids are involved in collecting the change each Sunday and then using that change to serve others.
