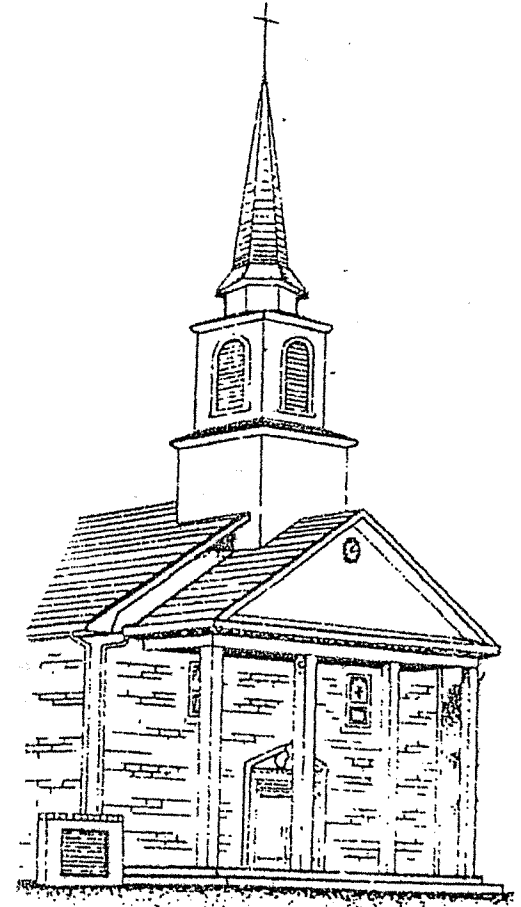

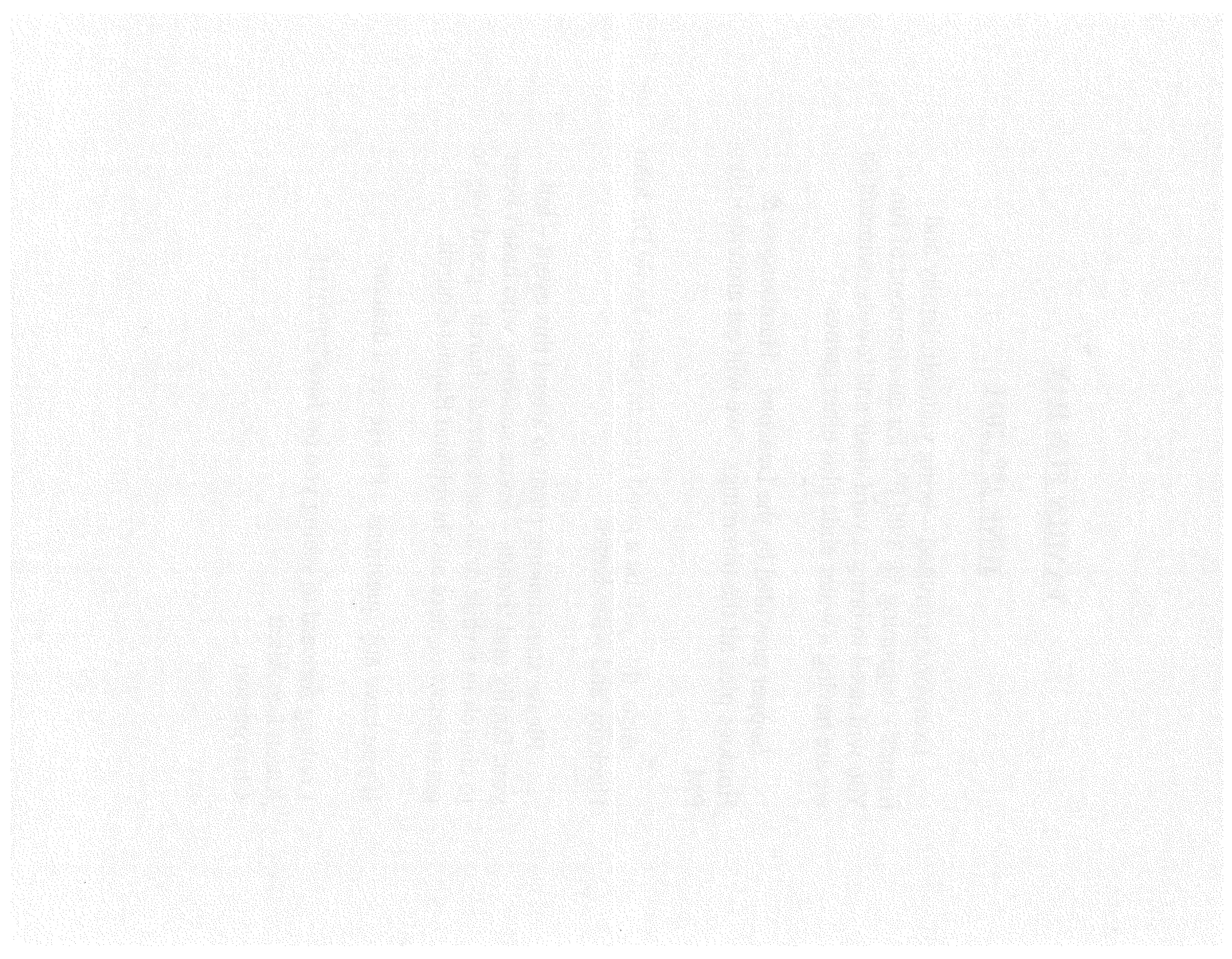
Supper provided by the Deacons – Hamburgers & Hotdogs plus all the trimmings – we will eat around 5:30 PM.

New Beginnings
Joshua 1:1-11



Introduction – what does God’s Word have to say to us on this day of new beginnings?

The p_____ is the p_____ the p_____ is the f_____ (1:1-2). After the death of Moses, the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses’ aide: ²“Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites.

God’s p_____ for the p_____ and the f_____ (1:3-5). ³I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. ⁴Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. ⁵No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.

God’s c_____ for the p_____ and the f_____ (1:6-9) ⁶Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them. ⁷“Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. ⁸Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. ⁹Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.”

Conclusion – as chapter 1 closes Joshua issues the final challenger in verse 11: **Go through the camp and tell the people, ‘Get your provisions ready. Three days from now you will cross the Jordan here to go in and take possession of the land the LORD your God is giving you for your own.’**”
