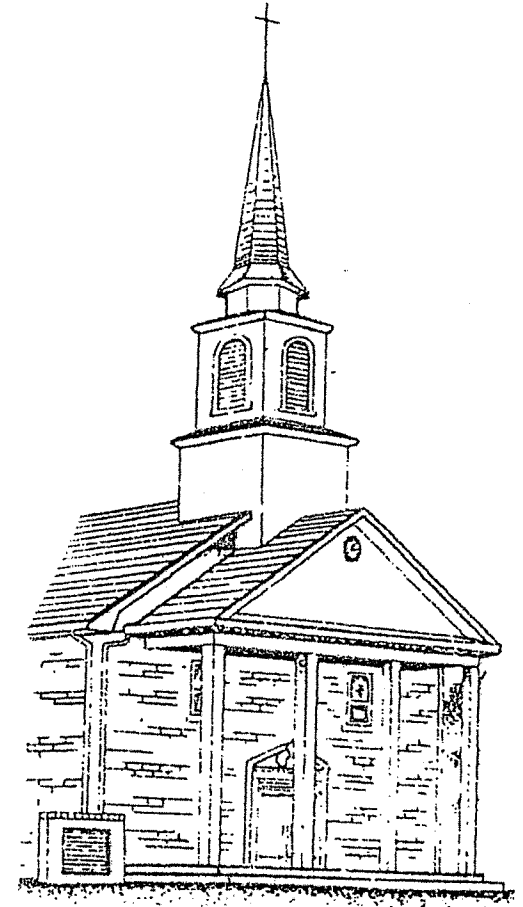

Also, this will be a good time to get to know Dr. John Huckaby and wife; Karen.

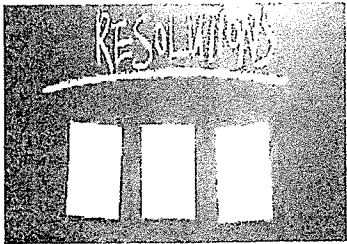

## Resolutions Sermon Series from The Gospel of Luke

**Overview** – everyone (of most) make new year's resolutions at the beginning of a new year. For these next few weeks, I want us to think about four resolutions taken from Scripture that will guide us during the coming year.

### Resolution #1

#### Launch into the Deep/Drop the Net Luke 5:1-11

**Introduction** – it had been a horrible night of fishing for the Zebedee fishing business. But when Jesus got into their boat, all of that changed. As we look toward a new year as a church one of our resolutions will be drop the net.



**Dropping the net means meeting Jesus at the point of our f\_\_\_\_\_**  
(vv. 5a, 8-10)

<sup>5</sup> Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything."

<sup>8</sup> When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!" <sup>9</sup> For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, <sup>10</sup> and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.

**Dropping the net means getting out of our c\_\_\_\_\_ z\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 4)**

<sup>4</sup> When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch."

**Dropping the net means a p\_\_\_\_\_ c\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 10b-11)**

Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." <sup>11</sup> So they pulled their boats up on shore, **left everything and followed him.**

**Conclusion** – and they left everything and followed Jesus.
