

Resolutions Sermon Series from The Gospel of Luke

Overview — everyone (of most) make new year's resolutions at the beginning of a new year. For these next few weeks, I want us to think about four resolutions taken from Scripture that will guide us during the coming year.

Resolution #1 Launch into the Deep/Drop the Net Luke 5:1-11

Introduction — it had been a horrible night of fishing for the Zebedee fishing business. But when Jesus got into their boat, all of that changed. As we look toward a new year as a church one of our resolutions will be drop the net.



Dropping the net means meeting Jesus at the point of our f_____(vv. 5a, 8-10)
