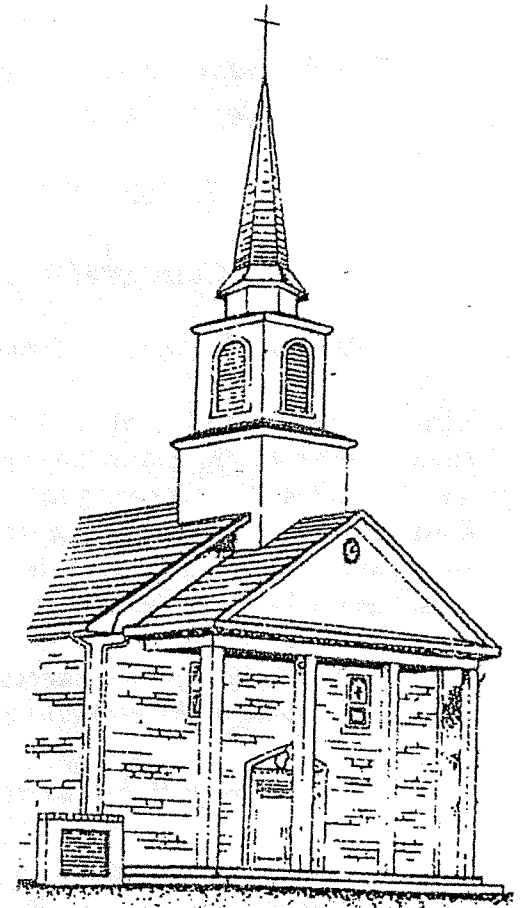

Introduction – today we look at our third resolution for these days of new beginnings. First we begin with:

### Explanation

**The S \_\_\_\_\_ : D \_\_\_\_\_ (5:18)** <sup>18</sup> Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus.

**The S \_\_\_\_\_ : W \_\_\_\_\_ it T \_\_\_\_\_ (5:19)** <sup>19</sup> When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus.

**The R \_\_\_\_\_ (5:20-26)**

**The H \_\_\_\_\_ (v.20)** <sup>20</sup> When Jesus saw their faith, he said, “Friend, your sins are forgiven.” So he said to the paralyzed man, “I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home.” <sup>25</sup> Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God.

**The C \_\_\_\_\_ (5:21)** <sup>21</sup> The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, “Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?”

**The A \_\_\_\_\_ (5:26)** <sup>26</sup> Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were filled with awe and said, “We have seen remarkable things today.”
