10:19-25

Introduction —the writer of Hebrews gives sound advice on graceful conversations:

Graceful conversation s_____ one another o_____ (10:24). ²⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds,

Graceful conversation is i_____ in the c_____ (10:25a) ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing

Graceful conversation always e_____ (10:25b). but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching
