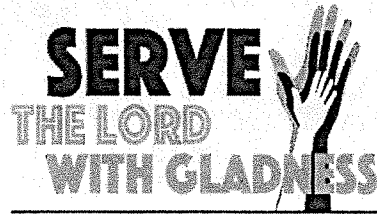

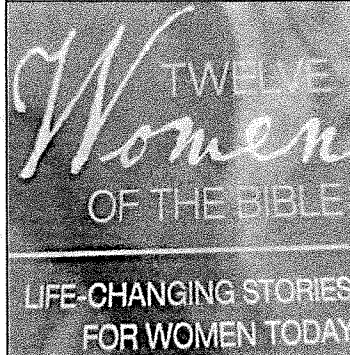

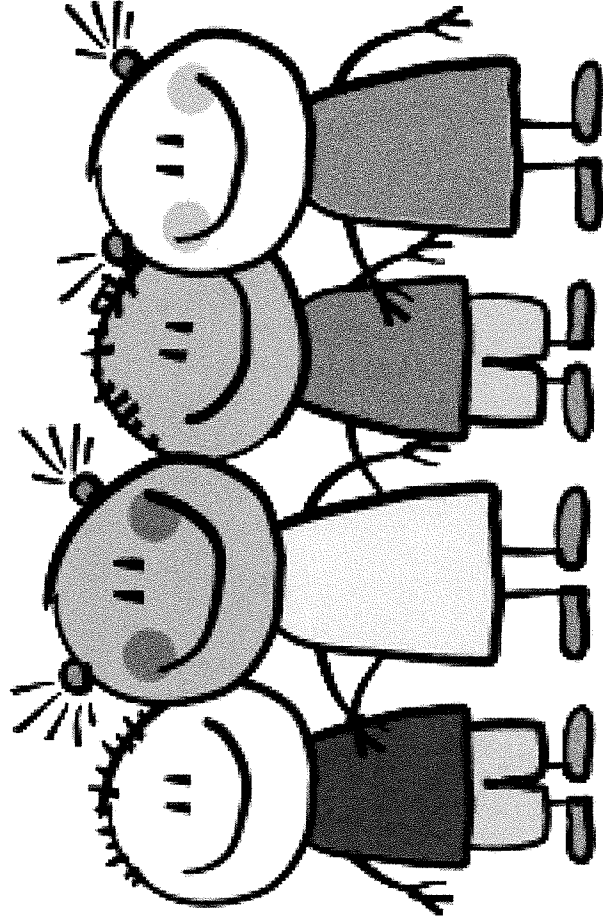

All About That Grace

Grace is Greater

2nd Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work

Introduction – over these last two weeks we've talked about sufficient grace and conversational grace. I want to close our series by looking at how God's grace is greater.

God's grace is greater than our s _____ (Romans 3:23-24).

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (3:23)

²³ For the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord (6:24)

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Jesus Christ died for us (Romans 5:8)!

⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast (Ephesians 2:8-9).

God's Grace greater than my b _____ (John 4 & 8).

Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Christ?"

neither do I condemn you, go and sin no more.

God's grace is greater than my f _____ and r _____ (John 21).

Conclusion – I believe the challenge this morning is both personal and corporate. I believe it's personal in that each of us must settle in our hearts that God's grace is greater than our sin.
