Sermon #1 - Joyful Relationships
Philippians 1:3-11

Relationships

Introduction – the apostle Paul, writing to a church he dearly loved, gives us wise principles for the relationship in our lives:

Be g_____ for the people God has placed in my life
(Philippians 1:3 & 5) ³ I thank my God every time I remember you. ⁵ because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now,

Joyfully p_____ for the people in my life (Philippians 1:4 & 1-9-11) ⁴ In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy

Pray they will grow in l_____ (v.9) ⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight,

Pray they will make w_____ c_____ (v.10) ¹⁰ so that you may be able to discern what is best

Pray they will live with i_____ (Philippians 1:11a) and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ,

Pray they will become like J_____ (v.9) ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

Expect the b_____ from people in my life (Philippians 1:6) ⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

L_____ people in my life like Jesus I_____ (Philippians 1:7-8). ⁷ It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. ⁸ God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.
