2.	The path to happiness comes from h (vv. 3b-5) Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, 4 not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
3.	The path to happiness is following the m of J (2:6-8) ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:
	Don't d what you think you d (v.6). ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage.
	Be a s(v. 7) ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
	Do the rt, even if it brings p(v.8) ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

Conclusion - I began with the question of what's the true path to happiness and the answer to the question is easy. The answer is Jesus.






