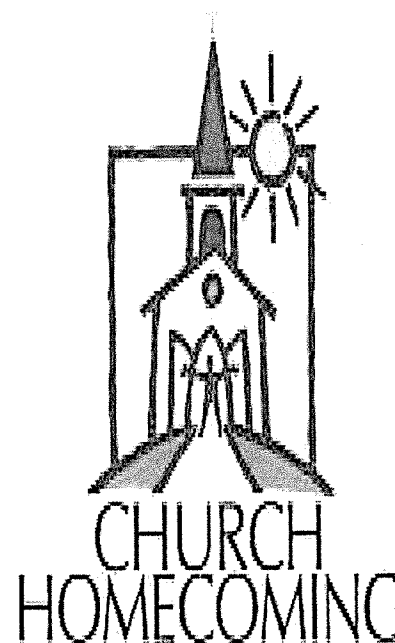

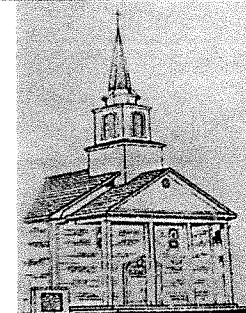

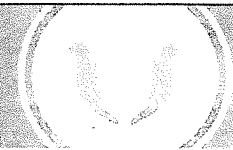

This month the food pantry is collecting juice for weekend food bags, squeezable jelly, Mashed potatoes Squeezable jelly, and Canned meat.

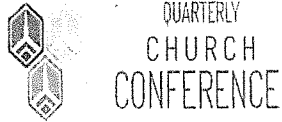
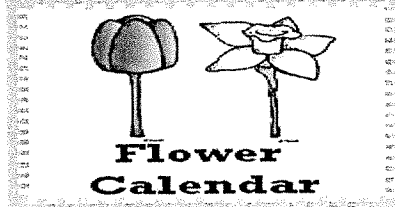

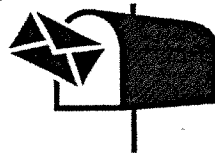
