Principle #1: Check Your D_____ (3:12-14)

Realize I haven’t a_____ (3:12, 13a) ²Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, ¹³ Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it.

Press toward the g_____ (v.12b; 13b;14) but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me and straining toward what is ahead, ¹⁴I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Principle #2: F_____ F_____ L_____ (3:15-17)

⁵ All of us, then, who are mature should take such a view of things. And if on some point you think differently that too God will make clear to you. ¹⁶ Only let us live up to what we have already attained. ¹⁷ Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.

Principle #3: K_____ Your E_____ (3:18-19)

⁸ For, as I have often told you before and now tell you again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ. ¹⁹ Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things.

Principle # 4: Remember Your T_____ I_____ 20-21

²⁰ But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,

Conclusion – we’re all on a journey to be Gold Standard Christians, to live for the well done at the close of our life.



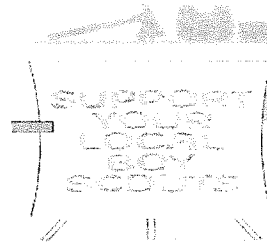
