"In EVERYTHING give thanks..."  
1 Thessalonians 5:18

**Introduction** – it is a fact that storms will come into our lives. We don't often like them, nor do we look forward to them, but they are reality. What does God's Word say about the storms of life?

God uses storms to remind us to s\_\_\_\_\_ g\_\_\_\_\_ (12:7a). To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations

God uses storms to remind me I have an e\_\_\_\_\_ (12:7b). there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me.

God uses storms to remind us of His s\_\_\_\_\_ g\_\_\_\_\_ (12:8-9). <sup>8</sup> Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. <sup>9</sup> But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

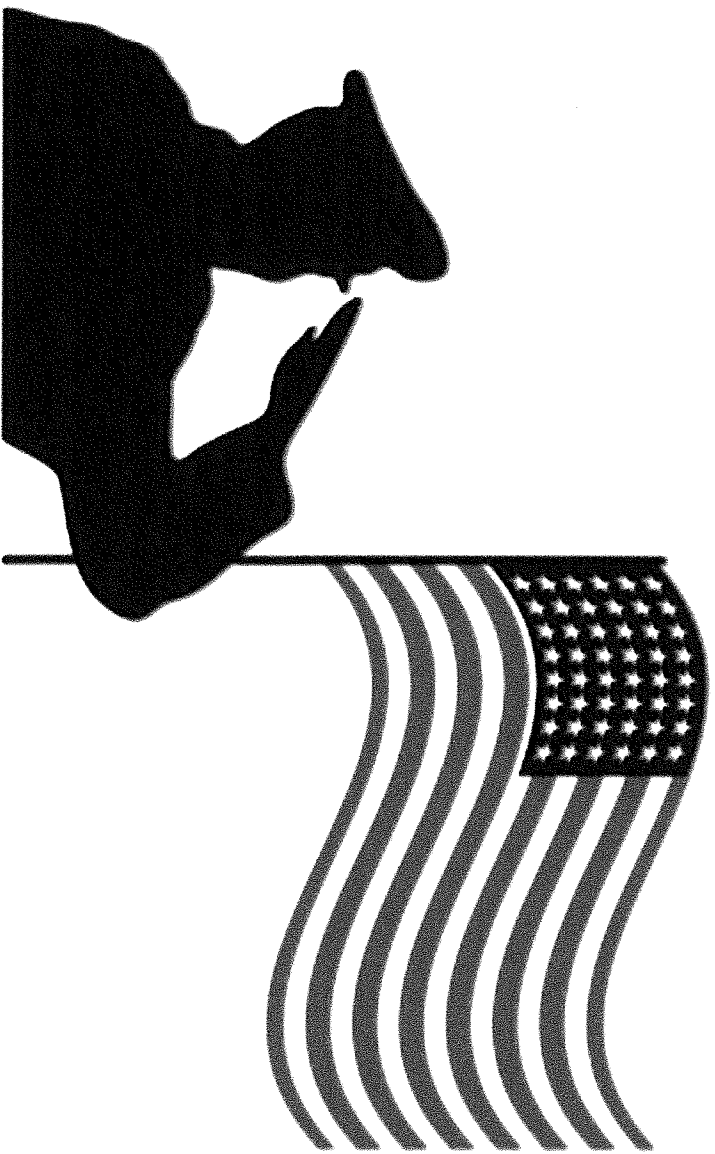
