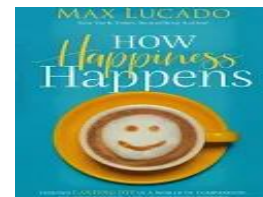

## My Place at the Table 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

**Introduction** – Jesus gave us two ordinances in the church that we should observe, baptism and communion. It's important that we come to the Lord's Table prepared to meet him. As we look at Scripture there is a significance to this table.

This table is a place to r\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus (12:23-25)

We should remember his s\_\_\_\_\_ (11:23-24) For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.

We should remember his d\_\_\_\_\_ on the c\_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 11:25) In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.

We should remember w\_\_\_\_\_ he d\_\_\_\_\_ it – for our s\_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 26:28). This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

The Table is a place to celebrate God's f\_\_\_\_\_ and g\_\_\_\_\_ (11:25)

We should thank God for the f\_\_\_\_\_ of our s\_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 11:25). This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.

We should marvel in God's gracious i\_\_\_\_\_ to come (John 6:35-37) Jesus said: "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty ... All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away.

This table is a place to share in C\_\_\_\_\_ f\_\_\_\_\_

The v\_\_\_\_\_ dimension – we share f\_\_\_\_\_ with Christ (Psalm 34:8; 1 Peter 2:2-3) Taste and see that the Lord is good."

The h\_\_\_\_\_ dimension - We share in fellowship with e\_\_\_\_\_ o\_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 10:17) Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf.

This table is a place to anticipate C\_\_\_\_\_ r\_\_\_\_\_ (11:26) For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

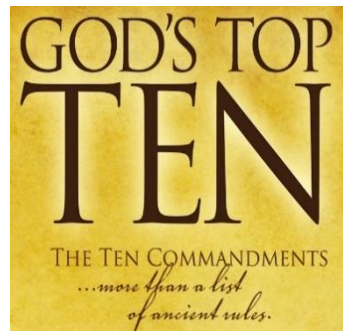
