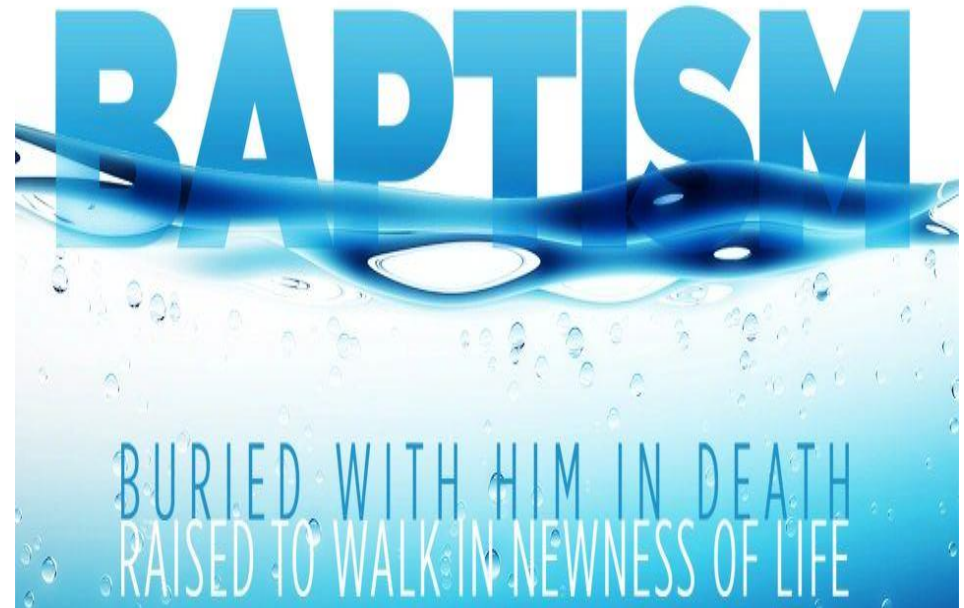

Elder Brother Religion

Luke 15:25-32

Introduction – our text this morning describes Elder Brother Religion.

Elder brother religion enjoys no c_____ (vv. 25-28). ²⁵“Meanwhile, the older son was in the field. When he came near the house, he heard music and dancing. ²⁶So he called one of the servants and asked him what was going on. ²⁷‘Your brother has come,’ he replied, ‘and your father has killed the fattened calf because he has him back safe and sound.’ ²⁸“The older brother became angry and refused to go in. So his father went out and pleaded with him.
