## Too Blessed to Be Stressed (Part two) Psalm 23:1-6

**Introduction** – there are at least six things in life that can cause us stress. The Psalmist, in the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm, gives us wise insight into how to handle our stress. For each of the things that cause stress, there is an admonition from Scripture.

**To handle the stress of worry, I must look to God to meet all my needs (v. 1).** The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

**To handle the stress of hurry I must obey God's command to rest (v.2a).** <sup>2</sup>He makes me to lie down in green pastures.

**To handle the stress of the crowds, I need to observe the beauty around me (v.2b-3).** He leads me beside the still waters. <sup>3</sup>He restores my soul<sup>3</sup> He restores my soul;

**To handle the stress of c \_\_\_\_\_, I need to seek God's g \_\_\_\_\_**  
(3b) He leads me in the paths of righteousness. For His name's sake.

**To handle the stress of losing my p \_\_\_\_\_, I need to t \_\_\_\_\_**  
**God all the time, even in the d \_\_\_\_\_ v \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4)** <sup>4</sup>Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You *are* with me Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

**To handle the stress of p \_\_\_\_\_ I will let God be my d \_\_\_\_\_**  
(v.5). <sup>5</sup>You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

**To handle the stress of the f \_\_\_\_\_ of the f \_\_\_\_\_ I look for God to f \_\_\_\_\_ what he s \_\_\_\_\_ in me (v.6)** <sup>6</sup>Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life And I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever.

**Conclusion** – follow the advice of the Psalmist to reduce your stress.

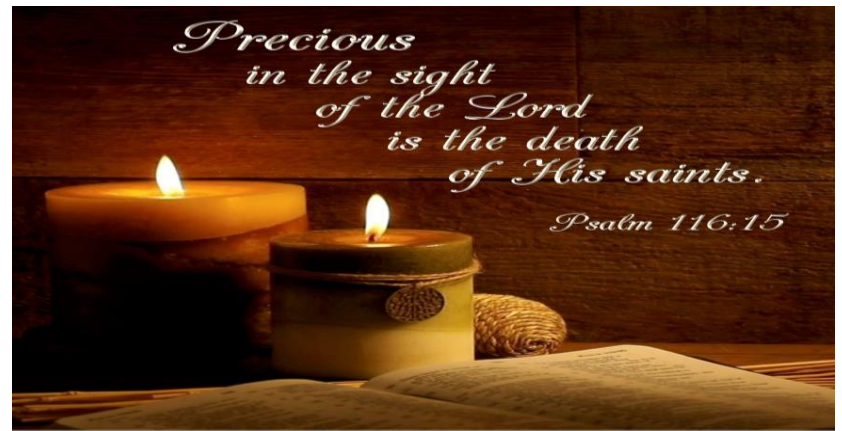
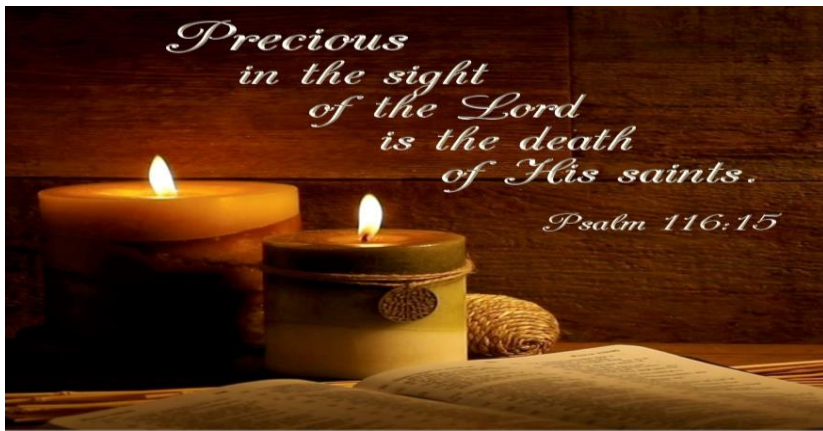
