Introduction – what would it take for spiritual renewal to sweep across this community in such a way that it would forever change the face of this community? The answer to that question is found in our text:

B _____ (1:1-4a) The words of Nehemiah son of Hakaliah: In the month of Kislev in the twentieth year, while I was in the citadel of Susa, ²Hanani, one of my brothers, came from Judah with some other men, and I questioned them about the Jewish remnant that had survived the exile, and also about Jerusalem. ³They said to me, “Those who survived the exile and are back in the province are in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire.” ⁴**When I heard these things, I sat down and wept.**

They replied, “Let us start rebuilding.” **So they began this good work.**

Motion – the Technology Committee and deacons recommend accepting a quote from Precision Technical Solutions for upgrades to our video system and lighting to enhance our worship and communication. It involves four steps:

1. **The installation of two short throw laser projectors on each side of the baptistry.** This will **not** require a screen or monitor on the wall. This will allow us to discontinue using the center projector and screen which blocks the baptistry and the cross. This will also provide a clearer picture and give us more options to communicate.
2. **The installation of a monitor at the rear of the church on the balony overhang** which will allow the pastor to be able to see the slides (scripture/outline) and also those on stage to be able to see the words to hymns, songs, or notes.
3. **The installation of stage lights on pulpit.** Our current lighting (one light) on the stage is not adequate for filming worship due to the light from the windows. This will also provide additional light for programs and events.
4. **Purchase a Dell computer with church presentation software (Media Shout) to be used during worship (hymns, video, sermon outline).** We are currently using the pastor's laptop for presentation.
