

## Is My Worship Really Pleasing to God? Mark 11:15-17

<sup>15</sup> On reaching Jerusalem, Jesus entered the temple courts and began driving out those who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves, <sup>16</sup> and would not allow anyone

to carry merchandise through the temple courts <sup>17</sup> And as he taught them, he said, "Is it not written: 'My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations'? But you have made it 'a den of robbers.'

## **Motion from Technology Committee and Deacons**

Presented as information 1/22/23. Explained by Chair of Deacons 1/29/23. Vote on 02/05/23

**Motion** – the Technology Committee and deacons recommend accepting a quote from Precision Technical Solutions for upgrades to our video system and lighting to enhance our worship and communication. It involves four steps:

- 1. The installation of two short throw laser projectors on each side of the baptistry. This will not require a screen or monitor on the wall. This will allow us to discontinue using the center projector and screen which blocks the baptistry and the cross. This will also provide a clearer picture and give us more options to communicate.
- 2. The installation of a monitor at the rear of the church on the balony overhang which will allow the pastor to be able to see the slides (scripture/outline) and also those on stage to be able to see the words to hymns, songs, or notes.
- 3. The installation of stage lights on pulpit. Our current lighting (one light) on the stage is not adequate for filming worship due to the light from the windows. This will also provide additional light for programs and events.
- 4. Purchase a Dell computer with church presentation software (Media Shout) to be used during worship (hymns, video, sermon outline). We are currently using the pastor's laptop for presentation. This is a desktop computer and which is a more stable setup and an upgrade to the software we are presently using.
