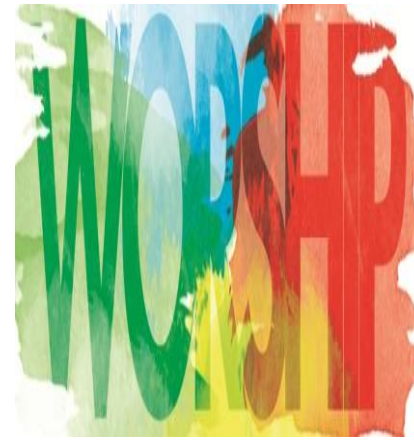
Real Worship m_____

G_____ (6:1-4) In the year that King Uzziah died, **I saw the Lord** seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another: “**Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty**; the whole earth is full of his glory.” **At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds** shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

Real Worship causes a c_____ (6:5-7) "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." **Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar.
