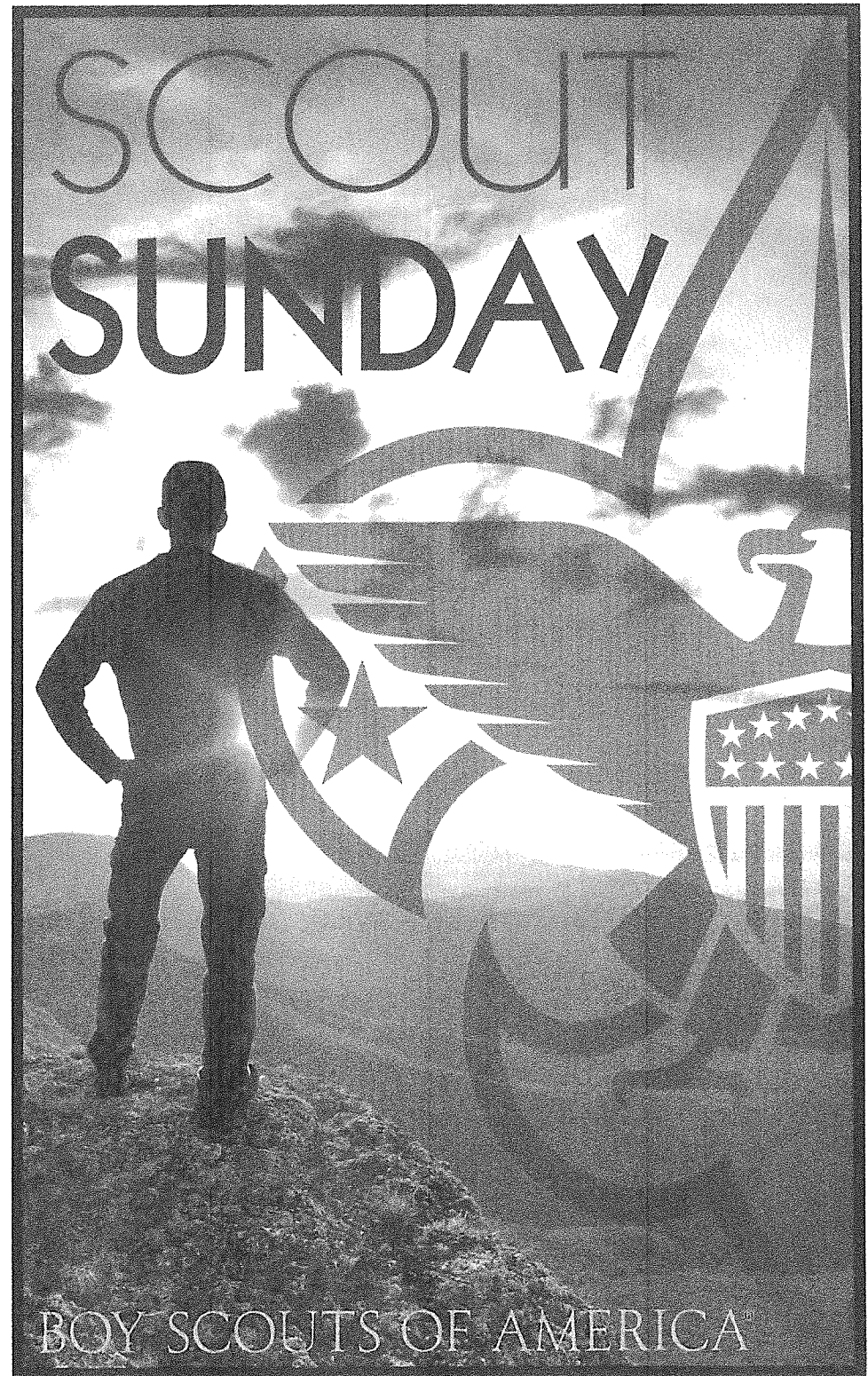


A Scout Is Reverent

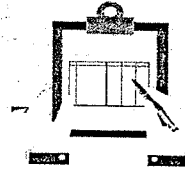
