# true religion

<sup>26</sup> Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless. <sup>27</sup> Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world (James 1:26-27).

**Introduction** – what does true religion look like? Well, there are many answers to that question but James gives us three tests to see if our religion, that outward expression of our salvation, is pleasing and acceptable to God.

**Sign #1** C\_\_\_\_\_ (1:26) <sup>26</sup> Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless.

**Sign # 2** C\_\_\_\_\_ (1:27a) Pure and undefiled religion before our God and Father is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress.

**Sign # 3:** C\_\_\_\_\_ (1:27b) To keep oneself unstained by the world.

**Conclusion** – so here's the question: Do you know Jesus? Have you trusted Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior? If you have are you living like Him? Is Christ living in your Monday through Saturday just like He is on Sunday? Which one of these is the area where you need to work?
