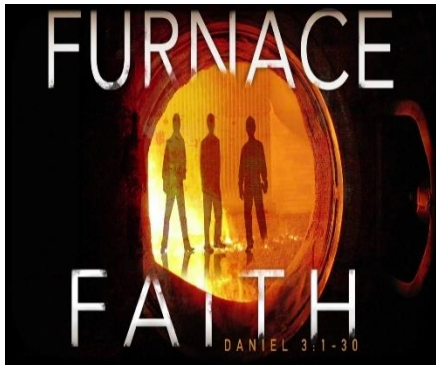

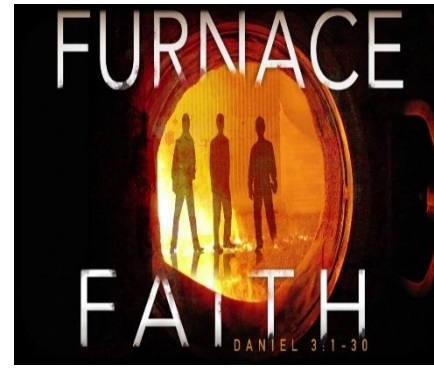
Introduction – the story of Shadrack, Meshack and Abednego tell us the story of a furnace faith and has application in our lives today.
