Food Pantry update for the month of March 330 Families were served 14005 individual helped 420 backpacks filled





Where were you May 16-17, 1987? That was a special weekend at Churchland Baptist as many of us celebrated the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our church. In 1837, Pine Meeting house was formed with a group of 11 members including a man of color. A detailed account of the formation and growth of the church, it's members, buildings and changes over time can be found in the Reflections book written by the anniversary

committee in 1987. Nancy Swicegood has copies for loan in our library.

The weekend that we remember as our 150<sup>th</sup> celebration took a year of planning from a dedicated group. Only one of those committee members remain as we have lost the others over time. Ask around to find out who that hard working CBC member is that gave countless hours to helping make the event happen.

Many activites took place that gave meaning to our remembrance of our 150 years. Numerous members of all ages were involved. We held tours, enjoyed demonstrations of locals who had skills such as quilting, woodworking and much more. Horse drawn buggy rides were available along with old timey games. Pictures and other displays of former pastors, buildings and artifacts were viewed.

Our minister during this celebration was Rev. Paul Millwood. His leadership assisted in many ways. Services were held as we recognized several former pastors with one of our speakers being Leila Shepherd Stennett, a lifelong member and first female ordained pastor in our church.

Dinner on the ground was one of the highlights of the week as we dressed in period attire and reminisced about our long ago heritage.

Fun fact about those who attended: The youngest who was here for that event, only a few months old is still a present member of CBC, active with his own family here. Ask those who would have been present to find out who he is!

2037 will be the next milestone in the life of our church. Be there when we open our time capsule containing items and artifacts from 1987. If you haven't seen it's location, look around in the front of the church yard, as it has a concrete marker lined up with the church cornerstone. Or ask a history committee member to point it out. Put 2037 on your long term calendar to celebrate our 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary. It is not too early to start planning and looking forward to the next century of worship, fellowship and growth at Churchland Baptist.
