

The kids of Churchland Baptist stay quite busy.
Our goal is to teach them about Jesus while instilling a heart for service at a young age. We do mission projects each month that spans across all of our various activities.

We have Kids Connct each Wednesday. We begin the evening with a meal then go to our class to

learn about Jesus. We watch a video Bible story and then talk about how that story relates to the kids' lives. They earn "bucks" for answering questions and by attendance. We go over our prayer requests and it is always touching to see what is on their hearts and minds. We typically have an activity or craft that goes along with our story. Then they get to spend their "bucks" in our Kids Connect store.

We also have Children's Church every Sunday during the worship service. We have a Bible story video and then talk about the story after the video. It is always amazing to hear their insights on the stories. Then we do an activity or craft. On the 4th Sunday of the month, we collect Change for Change at the end of the worship service. This money collected goes towards our monthly mission project.

We have VBS coming up June 23-26, 6 pm – 8pm. Our theme is Scuba and we are so excited! This is also one of our biggest outreach opportunities of the year. We normally have children from all over the community and this may be the only time they hear about how much Jesus loves them. We will have music, stories, crafts, games and snacks each night. The kids also bring offerings each night and compete between the boys and girls to see who can collect the most...their prize is getting to throw pies at one of the volunteers...and they LOVE that! The money collected goes towards supplies for our Back to School Scavenger Hunt in August.

Some of the other activites we will have through the rest of the year, in addition to VBS and the Back to School Scavenger Hunt are the Fall Festival in October and Children's Christmas Play in December. Please keep an eye out for the dates.

Lastly, we can always use more volunteers for Kids Connect and Children's Church. We also need lots of volunteers for VBS. As said earlier, this is one of our biggest outreach opportunities and it takes a lot of people to make this event happen.
