A Brief History of Troop and Pack 232

Troop 232 was chartered by Churchland Baptist Church in February 1986. Benny Shoaf has been registered as Institution Head since the start. Ronald Hartley was the first Scoutmaster, serving in the position for nineteen years. Eddie Taylor and Tim Henderson were the first Assistant Scoutmasters. Our original five scouts were Robbie Young, Daniel Hartley, Matt Beck, Eric Taylor and Steven Deamer. Craig Swicegood joined during the

first year of our scout charter. Of those six scouts, Robbie, Daniel and Craig achieved the rank of Eagle. We have traditionally been a small troop avering six to ten scouts. Over the years we have had three sets of brothers to earn their Eagle rank. Craig and Michael Swicegood, Daniel and Jacob Powers, Chandler and Espen Brock. Some of our scouts have attended Florida Sea Base in Islamorada, Fl, Philmont Scout Rance in Cimarron, NM, National Jamboree at Fort A. P. Hill, Va, Great Smoky Mountains and Grand Canyon National Parks. Other then being involved with our troop some of our scouts have served on summer camp staff at Camp Uwharrie and Camp Cherokee. Some have even served on staff for the National Jamboree. On average 2% of scouts registered earn the rank of Eagle. As of this writing Troop 232 has had twenty scouts earn the rank of Eagle. They are Robbie Young, Daniel Hartley, Craig Swicegood, Ronnie Willis, Scott Gregory, Eric Roland, Michael Swicegood, Brian Mills, Michael Price, Daniel Powers, Jacob Powers, Chandler Brock, Noah Tribley, Chase Smith, Austin Barbee, Andrew Tedder, Nathaniel Pressley, Kirby Flake, Shane Fox and Espen Brock. Other Scoutmasters over the years have been Steve Riddle, Scott Gregory, Andy Barbee and our current Scoutmaster is Chad Tedder. Our current Assistant Scoutmaster is Jeff Fox.

Pack 232 was chartered by Churchland Baptist Church in October 1993. Gerri Hartley was the first Cubmaster to serve in that position for five years. The Arrow of Light is the highest award a cub scout can earn and is the only cub scout award that can be worn on the boy scout uniform. Cub Scouts who earned the Arrow of Light in Pack 232 and went on to earn Eagle in Troop 232 are Brian Mills, Michael Price, Daniel Powers, Jacob Powers, Austin Barbee and Andrew Tedder. Other cubmasters over the years have been Jerry Smith, Jery

Koonts, Stuart Britt, Chad Tedder, Rondall Owens, Trina Shepherd Wilson and our current Cubmaster is Melissa Swicegood. Gerri Hartley has served as pack 232 Committee chairperson for twenty-six years and as Troop 232 Committee Chairperson for four years.

On July 1, 2001, we held a dedication ceremony for the Tony Barbee Scout Center to honor the memory of Assistant Scoutmaster, Tony Barbee who lost his life in a tragic accident. The Tony Barbee Scout Center is where our boy scouts, cub scouts and girl scouts hold their weekly meetings, Courts of Honor, Pack Meetings and family gatherings.

This has been a brief history because it is difficult to condense thirty-eight years of history into one page. Please forgive me if I have left someone's name out or misstated a date.
