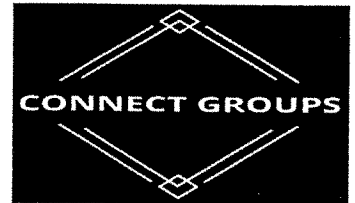

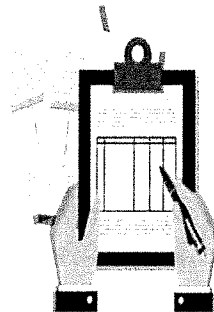

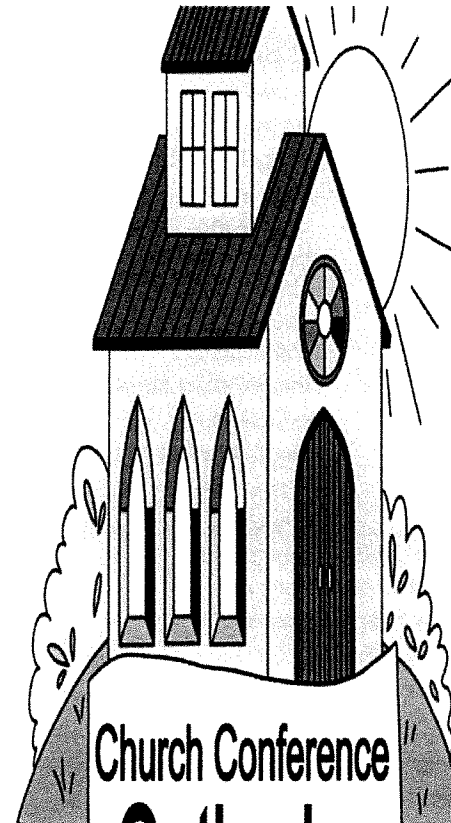

Due to the age, the roof over the sanctuary is deteriorating. After viewing several options, it is the recommendation of the Building & Grounds that the entire sanctuary building be re-covered with new underlayment plus 30 year shingles. The total cost is \$50,000. The Finance Committee proposed that the work be done with the funds coming from the Building Fund. This will be voted on next Sunday.



We are in desperate need for Soup. The month of August we will be collecting soup, canned meat and green beans and corn

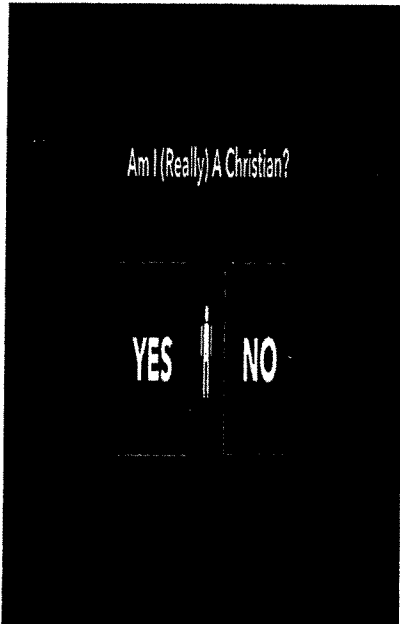

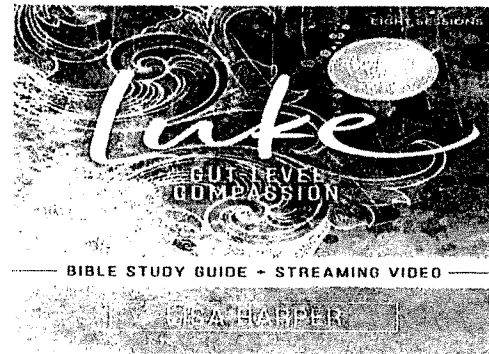
