STEP INTO THE STORY – APRIL 2025

Annie Armstrong was a lay Southern Baptist denominational leader instrumental in the

founding of the WMU (Women's Missionary Union) of which she was elected in 1882 as the

corresponding secretary.

Annie was born in Baltimore Maryland on July 11, 1850. She came from a long line of

prominent Baptists. At the age of 20 she had a spiritual awakening to Christ and was a "born

again Christian".

She organized women to come together to pray and meet the needs around them. She

challenged pastors and their churches to take action and support missionaries in the United

States, Canada and surrounding territories. Annie had an unstoppable passion for missions and she was recognized as the Southern Baptist trailblazer for her visionary leadership that still

inspires millions today. In one year Annie wrote 18,000 letters to churches bringing awareness

of the need of support through prayer and offerings to support missionaries.

Through her time of serving Annie traveled and served other areas on her own expense and

never accepted any salary. That is just how passionate she was in serving her God. Annie was

a tireless advocate for missionaries, rallying to the churches to support missionaries.

Annie played a big role in securing funds to relieve China's missionary, Lottie Moon, who had

served 11 years without a furlough.

Annie mobilized women to reach beyond the bounds of race by organizing missions to African

Americans and Native Americans.

Annie helped plant churches. Annie was from a wealthy family, but her heart and passion was

to serve those that lived in poverty and addictions.

A beautiful quote from Annie Armstrong is "What a glorious thing it is to be a co-worker with

God in winning the world for Christ".
