QUARTERLY CHURCH CONFERENCE

There will be a Quarterly Church Conference next Sunday, Sept. 28 following the morning worship service. The following recommendations will be presented and voted on at the conference. Copies of the reports and church calendar are located in the church foyer.

RECOMMENDATION #1

The Deacons, Finance Committee and Safety Team recommend we replace the 9 existing cameras and add 3 new for a total of 12 cameras at a cost of \$5,189.50 from Piedmont Communications and that we pay for this with funds from the Building Fund.

Explanation:

There are some blind spots with existing cameras and adding new ones will help eliminate them. Also, Piedmont Communications no longer sells the system we have and new cameras are not compatible with the old ones. Three (3) bids were obtained and Piedmont was the most reasonable one plus they are local and give us good service when needed.

RECOMMENDATION #2

The Finance Committee recommends that we hire Laws Stained Glass Studios, Inc. to re-solder and add a steel brace bar under each of the 10 memorial name plates on the stained glass windows in the sanctuary at a cost of \$277.00 each for a total of \$2,770.00 and that the money for payment come from the Building Fund.

Explanation:

One name plate has already come loose and slid off the window. Six are loose and three seem fine at this time but we feel it would be in the best interest of the church to repair all 10 at one time. We do not want any of the plates to break and become damaged beyond repair.
